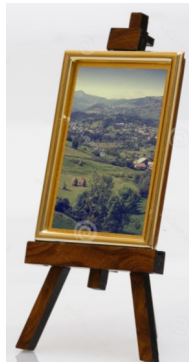

He was appointed Regional Chaplain for Ontario with the Correctional Service Canada (CSC) in December 2013. He has responsibility to ensure the delivery of Chaplaincy services in the Ontario Region of CSC and to ensure that offenders of all faiths receive services.
