It's Time!

In 2003, the Anglican Diocese of Toronto launched **Responsible Ministry: Screening in Faith**, a program to help parishes make sure their places of ministry are safe and healthy, especially for vulnerable children and adults who come to them in trust.

The Church couldn't operate without the work of individuals – clergy, staff, volunteers – who exercise a variety of ministries to people within the Church community and beyond. We need to make sure those in positions of power and trust are selected, trained and supported so that their ministry may be life-giving.

To that end, everyone who volunteers at, or is employed by, HTC is obliged to become familiar with the Diocesan Sexual Misconduct Policy (SMP). Those who are in high-risk positions must undergo a police record check (PRC). These actions must take place before individuals begin their ministry and every three years thereafter.

Our Christian values are consistent with the legal concept of "duty of care." Duty of care arises out of legal doctrines dealing with negligence. Everyone has a general obligation to conduct themselves in a way that doesn't cause damage to other people or their property. The duty of care is most obvious where a relationship of dependence exists.

Do I Need This?

It's now three years since COVID began to disrupt our patterns, and it's safe to say that **retraining is due for most people, if not every person, who ministers at HTC**. Your leadership has reviewed all volunteer and staff positions and determined who should have a PRC and who requires SMP training. The good news is that it's easy!

Over the next week, everyone concerned will receive an email with a link to the Diocesan online SMP training platform. You


... from the MUSIC DIRECTOR



If your ministry position is deemed high-risk, you will also be sent the forms necessary to complete a PRC. The completed forms may be brought to the office for transmission, and the associated cost will be reimbursed by HTC.
