In honour of the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation (Sept. 30, colloquially known as Orange Shirt Day), our gospel reading is from *First Nations Version: An Indigenous Translation of the New Testament*. Here is the same passage as it stands in the New Revised Standard Version:

When Jesus saw Nathanael coming toward him, he said of him, "Here is truly an Israelite in whom there is no deceit!" Nathanael asked him, "Where did you get to know me?" Jesus answered, "I saw you under the fig tree before Philip called you." Nathanael replied, "Rabbi, you are the Son of God! You are the King of Israel!" Jesus answered, "Do you believe because I told you that I saw you under the fig tree? You will see greater things than these." And he said to him, "Very truly, I tell you, you will see heaven opened and the angels of God ascending and descending upon the Son of Man."

ABOUT THE ART

Cloud Spirit by Joseph Sanchez

Joseph Sanchez has a unique place in the Canadian First Nations art movement. Born and raised in Arizona, Joseph lived in Canada in the 1970s and was a founding member of the Professional Native Indian Artists Association along-side Daphne Odjig, Alex Janvier, Norval Morrisseau and others. Known as both an artist and curator, Joseph's vast list of achievements includes Director and Chief Curator of the Institute of American Indian Arts in Santa Fe, New Mexico.

Joseph says, of the series of which this painting is a part, "I call this work *Grandmothers and Angels*, referring to the spirits that protect and guide us and to the elders who we must listen to in these times of great challenges."
