

This is a mid-summer update from the Joy Ministry team. Our work on the parish list is completed, for the moment; please remember to keep the office informed of any changes to your contact information. The parish telephone contacting is in progress. The first phase is near completion and the wider calling will start within the month. As we noted in Bulletin #1, this is just an outreach for a friendly conversation.

We would like to take this opportunity to remind you about two very important activities that are part of our responsibility - the Card & Prayer Shawl Ministries. Many of you will be familiar with them and may have even assisted with them from time to time but there have been some changes or modifications.

Card Ministry: "Get well soon" cards are sent when someone is sick, in the hospital or undergoing some extended treatment. Sympathy cards are sent when there has been a death in the HTC family or of a close friend. Seasonal cards are sent to a broader group of parish members (especially the sick or shut-ins) at Christmas and Easter. To request a card, please let Rev'd Maria and/or the office know and please make sure to include the address and all relevant details. Angella Smith and Linda Robertson are the leads for this ministry. Prayer Shawl Ministry: This is the continuation of a long-standing activity at HTC. This work provides an opportunity to contribute by knitting a shawl (wool and directions provided) as well as suggesting possible recipients. The prayer shawls are for any parishioner, their family or friends. They
