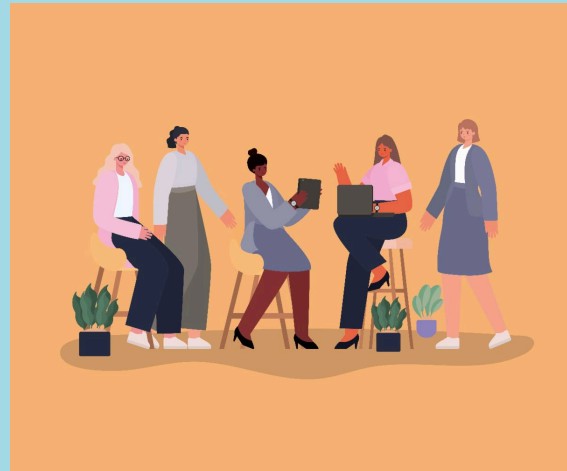

Holy Trinity has always been a generous donor to this program which has existed for many years. We will look forward to your support again next November.

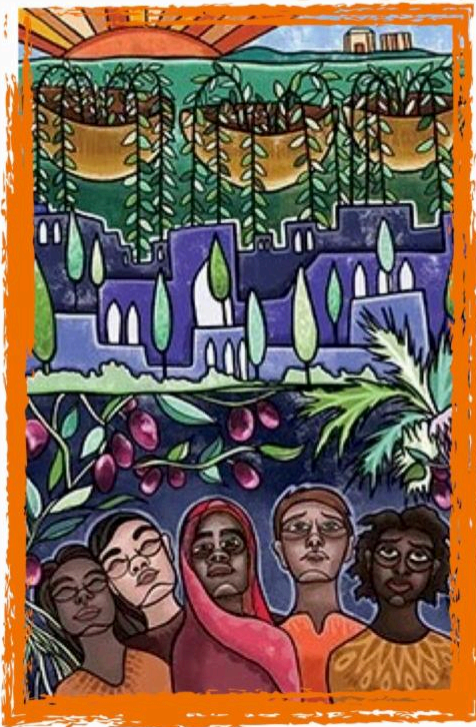
