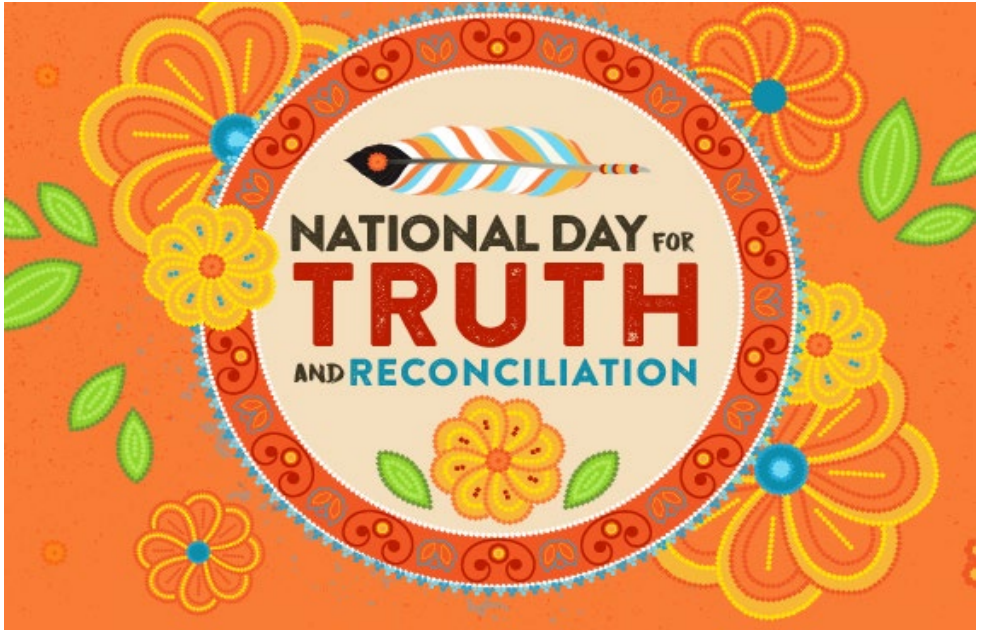

We have used the occasion of the National Day of Truth and Reconciliation to make some small changes to our prayer of acknowledgement. First, we have sought to more consistently honour the official names of the First Nations that we pray for. For example, we will pray for the Haudenosaunee peoples using their official name, the Haudenosaunee Confederacy. Also, we have sought to include some Mississauga nations who were present in our part of Southern Ontario that had previously been omitted: specifically, the Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation and the Curve Lake Nation. We hope that these changes will allow us to pray more intentionally for the peoples afflicted by settlement in our region.
